TREASURE'S REPORT

SECRETARY’S REPORT

The combo to the boathouse has been changed. If you are a paid member and don’t have it, contact one of the board members.

REAR COMMODORE’S REPORT

- The wheels on the dolly used for the lasers are flat. Malcolm volunteered to get new one & will be reimbursed.
- Mast repair. The halyard was broken and needed to be sent out to be repaired.
- Outhauls on the boats are not fitting in the catch mechanism. Some are too big and some are too small. Suggestion was to get some new line and replace them all.
- The new boat (red) that we had bought with the trailer is now on the dock and ready to be used.
- The Donated boat from BI was too waterlogged, making it too heavy and slow. No seaworthy. Boat will be stripped out for parts.

- The batten pockets on some of the sails are stretched out and won't hold the battens. Does anyone know how to sew sails? And figure out how to keep the battens from falling out?

Results of the above repairs tells us that we need to keep up on out inspections of the boats. Don't forget to inspect the lines as you rig your boat and before you take it out. It was suggested that we keep a maintenance binder in the boathouse and have separate tabs for each boat. Everyone has to document what needs to be repaired then let Josh know.

Malcolm had called the man with the kayak who was interested in storing the boat on our dock. No callback.

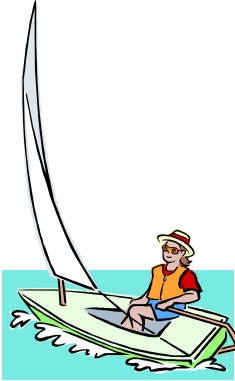

Life jackets are mandatory for everyone, including the skipper. 15 minute time limit on each boat ride.

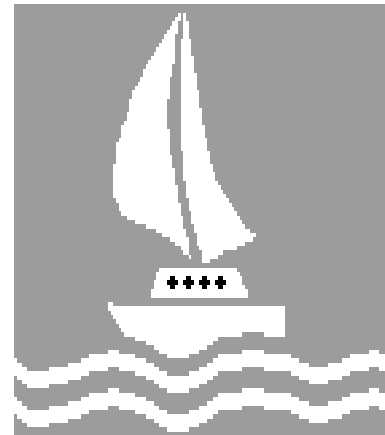
DO NOT go past the floating junk pier by the fuel dock.
