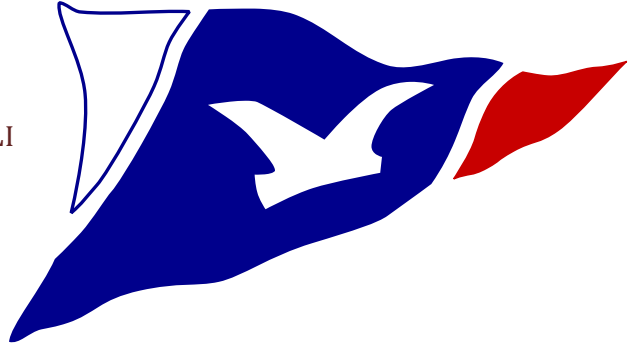

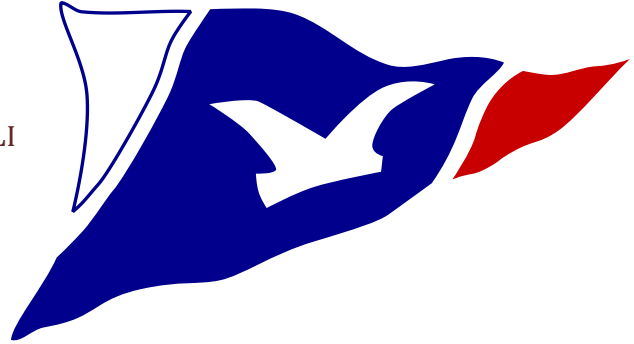

Troy is working on refurbishing a few rudders. He will take some pictures during the process so we can add them to the blog.

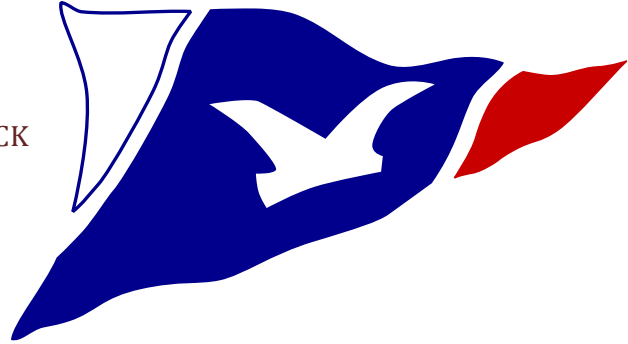
Troy brought in some new lines that he plans to rig the boats with this year. The lines looked like a great improvement over our current lines.

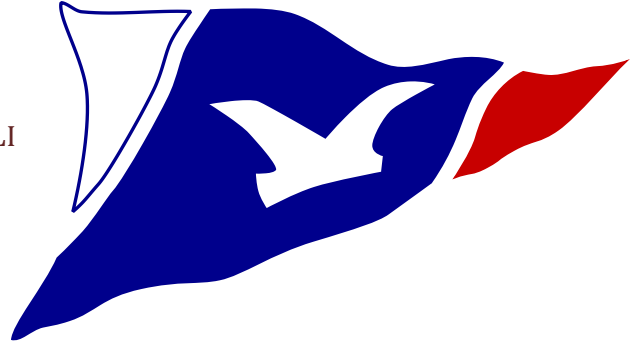

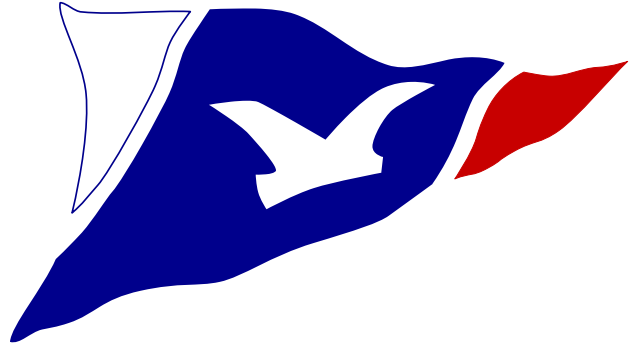

Race Day # 3 is scheduled for Father's Day, June 15.

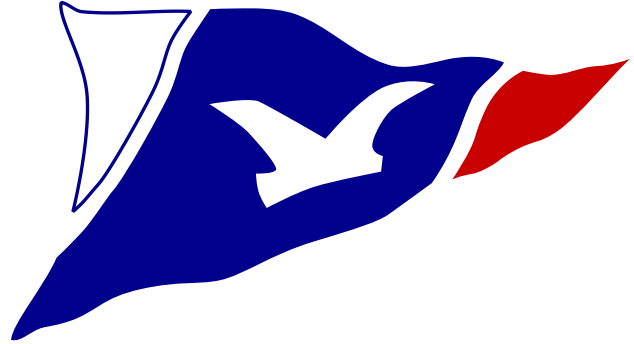

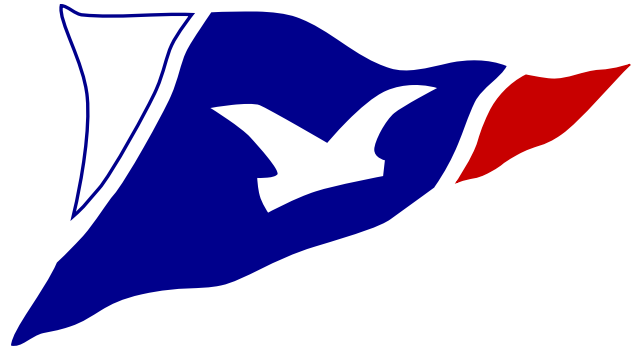
Laurie regrettably is not available for treasurer. The club wishes to acknowledge her years of faithful service with our finances.
